Dr. Ambedkar runs courses affiliated to RTM Nagpur University that includes MBA, MCM, BBA and BCCA.

Master of Business Administration (MBA)

The admissions of MBA course are centralized and are governed by Maharashtra Government body, Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai. DTE uploads process and method of admission on its official website www.dtemaharashtra.gov.in/mba every year for the students and the affiliated institutes. The Institute therefore follows the norms given by DTE for admission of students every year.

However, from 2012 to 2016, 20% seats and 10% for 2016 of intake capacity were filled by Management under Management Quota. The policy followed to fill these seats were as follows;

1. High CET scorers who missed CAP round to be given preference.
2. Merit students with good academic records to be given preference.
3. Merit students from other states to be considered.
4. Students who have done their graduation from Dr. Ambedkar Institute of Management Studies & Research, Nagpur to be given priority.

Every year, few numbers of genuine hard working and good scoring students miss CAP round due to unawareness, silly mistakes, wrong guidance and sometimes misunderstanding. When such students approach the Institute, due respect is given to their caliber by asking them to apply for the Management Quota seats where, they can compete for a seat on merit basis.

It has also been found that some students score less in their CET exam whereas; their academic record is sound and impressive. Such students are also considered for admission through Management Quota.

The Institute encourages metro culture. At least through Management Quota, Institute would like to encourage students from other states with different background, become part of the DAIMSR family.
